

Overview of the World Series of Bowling Format

In general, this proposed new scoring scheme for bowling events would attempt to use elements of wagering type formats found in tournament poker. In short, at the beginning of the tournament bowlers will be given betting/wagering units (similar to chips in poker). Bowlers will be required to make minimum bets (similar to antes in poker) prior to each game or series or alternative # of frames, etc. Bowlers will also be allowed to bet they can shoot a certain score (game, series, etc.) and will win an amount in a given multiple of that bet or lose the bet. The multiples are greater for corresponding higher scores (multiples could be varied depending on difficulty of condition). In addition to the required "ante," bowlers MAY bet from zero to all of their remaining units/chips (similar to No-Limit betting in poker). The winner will be decided by either the last survivor OR if at the end of some designated number of rounds, the bowler with the highest chip count. This should prove to be an exciting and fun format to use on occasion, the concept has recently been used in golf.

See following pages for an example of how this format might work (which uses actual scores from the 2007 US OPEN and makes reasonable assumptions on how bowlers might have bet had this new wagering format been in use).

**A possible "windfall" benefit for using a format like this is that it may take the focus off of absolute scores, may minimize left/right equity problems (especially IF multiple conditions are used), may allow a greater element of spectator interest following bowlers that are "all-in," could provide a scoring environment in which regulation ball multiple condition tourneys could be experimented with, may encourage greater participation by various skill levels of entrants, etc.

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World Series of Bowling

Using the Thompson Wagering Format

General Procedure:

- Multi-Stage Tourney (single games OR 3 game blocks each stage; could be Handicap and/or Scratch Divisions (Regular and/or Classified); could do over course of a League season; could use multiple patterns, could require equipment restrictions, could bet per 3 game blocks until finals where betting then goes game by game, etc.)
 - Entry Fee would vary tourney to tourney
 - All entrants receive BETTING UNITS or points which they can make a range of wagers ranging from the minimum/required bet, to betting ALL of their remaining units. Entrants would be making bets on what 3 game series score they believe they can bowl (or game by game). Depending on circumstances such as whether it is an early or late round and entrant's current relative standing, each entrant would make strategic decisions regarding how much to bet as at times they may think it is best to be conservative and at times think it is best to very aggressive and/or may wish to gamble.
 - Minimum Wager/Ante: Would vary depending on discretion of tourney director and whether wagering is game by game OR series by series.
 - Any entrant that does not have enough units to make required minimum wager will be All-In for all his/her remaining units/points.
 - Practice: The amount of practice and scope of practice will be determined tourney by tourney per discretion of tournament director.
 - Just after practice and prior to beginning each round bowlers sign a card marking their wager # (see Scoring Grid on right).
 - Bowlers earn or lose points based on whether they meet minimum score requirement corresponding to their wager # (ex., if make Wager #10 and bet 10 units then they will earn 200 points [10 units x Multiplier of 10] IF they bowl a series of 695 or greater, no extra units won should their score exceed Wager #10 minimum score - however - IF bowler fails to bowl a 695 he/she will lose entire amount of his/her wager, example if bowled a 650 then he/she would lose 10 units in this scenario).
 - If tourney rules allow, bowlers may also earn points based on Exotic Wagers (must be verified and witnessed by tournament official) and/or may earn Bonus points based on applicable Bonus Grid criteria (example bowler chooses to bet he/she can convert a difficult split OR bets he/she can roll a perfect game OR a clean series, etc.).
 - Elimination: Once bowlers lose all their betting units they are eliminated from the tournament.
- Order of Finish Determination (Tourney Complete): Final standings/order of finish is determined by comparing the # of betting units each participant possesses at end of final round.
- Order of Finish Determination (BEFORE Tourney Complete): If multiple participants are eliminated before final round is complete, the # of betting units each participant possessed prior to the round in which he/she was eliminated will be used to rank his/her order of finish relative to the other persons who were eliminated at same time. Example: Bowler A and Bowler B both were eliminated in Rd 3. Prior to beginning Rd 3 Bowler A had 25 betting units and Bowler B and 20 bettings units. Bowler A is deemed to have finished one position higher than Bowler B, etc. Alternative: Scratch Total of bowlers exiting at same time is used as tiebreaker.
- Could have version where whoever bets he/she will shoot highest score wins the chips of those who bet and lose.

Alternatives:

- Unlimited # of rounds until only 1 bowler remains (via increasingly raising level of ante). Similar to World Series of Poker.
- Different scoring scheme with HIGHER multipliers should participants choose to bowl on an assessed more DIFFICULT pattern. Order of which patterns used could be random.
- Could vary # of games per round, could change entry fees and wagering rules, could use multiple patterns round to round OR within a round, could have equipment/ball restrictions, etc.
- Could use a FORMULA for raising ante/required bet based on % of average points held by remaining competitors, also considering # of competitors left (ex., if 2 bowlers left then lowest ranked bowler may be required to bet 1/2 his/her points; if 3 competitors left then 3rd ranked bowler must bet 1/2 points, and 2nd ranked bowler must be 1/3rd, etc., something to speed tourney up).
- Could make the multipliers RISE as the rounds go by (i.e., in later rounds multipliers are higher than in early rounds). This would speed up the action and/or encourage aggressive wagering.
- To ensure honest conditions and if possible the oiling pattern should be shown to all (ex., turning glow lights on so ultraviolet additives can be seen, using colored oil, etc.)

- Possibility for records to be established with regards to multiplying units/points for future reference and challenge.
